The lost'ness of man

How lost is lost?

"perish" Gr. apollumi = to destroy fully; to loose away to loose or to be lost - to die!

Literally "to be fully lost / to be destroyed" in our sin

Romans 6:23

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Everyone / all of us / everyone born from Adam "is destined to perish / is fully lost / to be destroyed" in our sin

Romans 5:12

"Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned--

Romans 3:23

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,...... And the good news follows with the next verse

How lost is lost? Literally the whole of mankind is under the power of sin and it's consequences = DEATH

Galatians 3:22

"But the Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.

How lost is lost? We are looking at the total lostness of man / total depravity = he cannot save himself Whether man good or bad / righteousness or unrighteous HE CANNOT SAVE HIMSELF

> YAHU'SHUA Ye'shua (Jesus) "GOD IS MY SAVIOUR"

The Law cannot save you (Galatians 2:16) Your righteousness cannot save you (Isaiah 64:6) Living a good life cannot save you (James 2:10)

Only "GOD IS MY SAVIOUR" His provision is Jesus Christ of Nazareth Nothing else but the free love of the Father is the beginning of our salvation, and Christ is he in whom our righteousness and salvation dwells: and faith is the instrument or means by which we apprehend it, and everlasting life is that which is set before us to apprehend Geneva Bible. 1599
